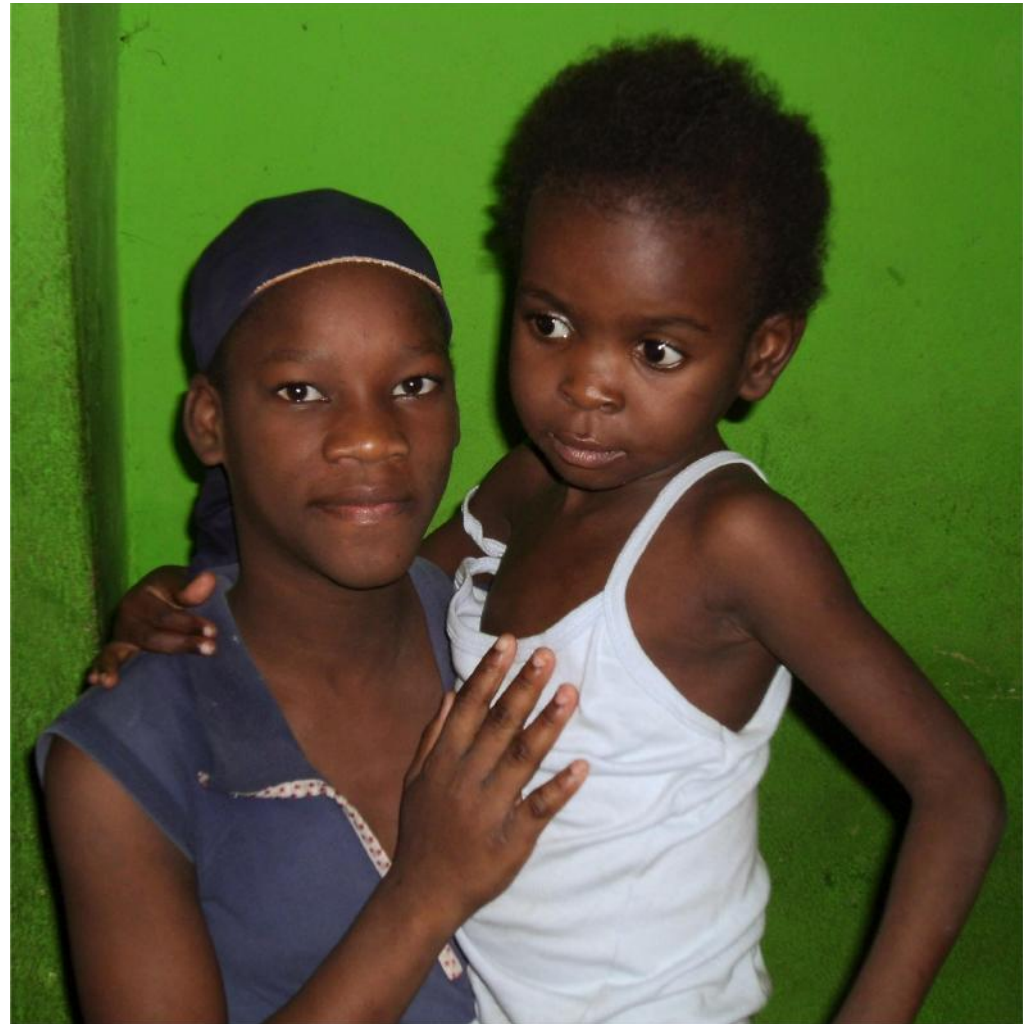


Thierrytson, age 10, witnessed his mother's brutal death by neighbors because of her positive HIV status
